

POSEIDON Field Peas



- Seed Color: Green.
- Yield Potential: Very high, stable from season to season. Longer pods characteristic.
- Disease Resistance: Strong Aphanomyces Resistance. Excellent choice for higher humidity climates.
- Cold Tolerance: Proven resilience to seeding into cold, wet soils in December and January in southern U.S. Very tolerant of freezing conditions in early vegetative growth.
- Flowering Interval: Relatively short.
- Markets: Suitable for human consumption and animal feed. Developed from a breeding program that selects for low Trypsin Inhibitor levels. Poseidon is an excellent protein source for both mono-gastric and ruminant animals.
- Standability: Closely knitted tendrils, High resistance to lodging.
